Be purposeful



- How can you use language that is inclusive?
- How can you provide students the opportunity to demonstrate and share their learning journey in a way that's relevant to their lives?
- How can your lessons help build relationships and self-awareness?

Meet student needs



- How can you get to know your students individually?
- How can you ensure each student is being appropriately challenged?
- How can you ensure learners have the right types of scaffold to engage in the learning process?
